**Student Accident and Sickness Insurance (SASI) Ineligible Academic Programs**

The University requires all students to carry adequate medical insurance either by 1) enrolling in the University provided Student Accident and Sickness Insurance (SASI) plan and paying a quarterly premium reflected on the students' account, or 2) waiving SASI by showing proof of enrollment in an alternate comparable plan. In addition, all students are assessed a quarterly Health and Wellness Fee which permits access to the Student Care Center (SCC) and Student Counseling and Resource Service (SCRS).

The following academic programs of study and enrollment statuses are the exceptions, and cause a student to be designated "ineligible for SASI". Programs ineligible for SASI will not be assessed the quarterly Health and Wellness Fee.

### **Programs with Inconsistent Rules**

1) Students in the following programs **are** eligible for SASI and **are** assessed the quarterly Student Health and Wellness Fee. However, they are **not** assessed the quarterly Activities Fee.

2) Students in the following program are **not** eligible for SASI but **are** assessed the quarterly Student Health and Wellness Fee **and** the Activities Fee.

3) Students in the following statuses **are** eligible for SASI, but they are **not** assessed the quarterly Student Health and Wellness Fee **or** the Activities Fee as they are understood to be more than 100 miles away from the main University campus for the duration of the quarter.

- Doctoral Pro Forma students
- Law School Study Away students
- College students on Study Abroad Programs

A student not in one of these three categories may request that his or her dean of students waive at the time of registration the Student Health and Wellness Fee and the Activities Fee, provided the student lives more than 100 miles from campus and is not taking classes on campus during the term of the waiver.

4) Students in the CIC and Exchange Scholars programs (through the Office of Graduate Affairs) whose home institution is either NU or UIC are not assessed the Activities fee. Also, these students are not assessed the Health and Wellness fee if they waive SASI.
